




Denver Health Saves Money & Increases Volume with ScriptDrop Prescription Delivery


ScriptDrop provides reliable and efficient same-day prescription delivery to Denver Health's vulnerable patient population at half the cost of local couriers.




Denver Health and Hospital Authority is a Federally Qualified Health Center and safety-net hospital system that serves approximately one third of Denver's population.

Delivery Journey

2004

Denver Health central fill pharmacy is established. Mail order begins.

2019

Only 2% of all dispensed medications were delivered via mail order.

2020

March

- March 6: The city of Denver reports its first COVID-19 cases.¹
- March 26: Statewide stay-at-home order begins.²
- Denver Health pharmacies begin same-day delivery with a local courier company.

April

- April 1: Governor Polis allows for expanded use of telehealth.³
- April 19: The Regional Transportation District reduced service plan goes into effect, which impacts many Denver Health patients who rely on public transportation.
- April 24: Denver-metro counties extend stay-at-home orders until May 8.4

June

Denver Health delivery orders rise 25% over previous month.

August

Denver Health launches ScriptDrop same-day and on-demand delivery at two locations.

October

8% of all dispensed prescriptions get to patients via mail order or sameday delivery.


Colorado's COVID-19 cases continue to climb.⁵

Like that of many health systems, Denver Health's delivery volume spiked in April, shortly after stay-at-home orders were enacted. But even when COVID-19 cases in Colorado dropped, Denver Health knew that delivery would still be an important and necessary service. To keep volume from dipping to pre-pandemic numbers, Denver Health took action.

• Marketing: Beginning in the summer, Denver Health's Marketing and Communications department developed robust and strategic cross-platform campaigns to promote mail-order and home delivery to both patients and staff. Among the many routes of communication, M&C sent mailers to patients, updated the Denver Health website and MyChart, and created magnets with information about delivery in both English and Spanish. Call center representatives also helped promote delivery to patients.

 Smart business decisions: Switching from a local courier to ScriptDrop has helped delivery volume grow far beyond expectations.

73% increase in same-day delivery volume

Two months after launching two locations with ScriptDrop, Denver Health's same-day delivery volume has risen 73% over July, the previous highest same-day volume month to date. By switching from a courier company to a healthcare technology company like ScriptDrop, patients will get their medications when they need them - and are more likely to trust the process.

50% decrease in administrative costs

Denver Health's average administrative costs dropped 50% when they switched from the local courier to ScriptDrop. In the case of Denver Health, working with ScriptDrop is a better use of their budget and allows them to provide pharmacy services to more patients than ever.

Pharmacy manager Warren Streck said, "I have been managing mail order pharmacies since 2004. In those years, I have not worked with a medication access company that understood the needs of our patients and our business like ScriptDrop does. With ScriptDrop, we can get our patients started on their regimens today!"

From November 2019 to November 2020, the rate of prescriptions sent by mail or delivery has jumped 391% for Denver Health's pharmacies.

But the Denver Health/ScriptDrop partnership is on track to expand delivery rates even further.

After all, as pharmacy manager Warren Streck stated, recent changes in the pharmacy landscape "compel us to work more closely together." Denver Health patients will expect more from their pharmacy.

Delivery has the potential to increase medication adherence and reduce rehospitalizations. With time, Denver Health's choice to use ScriptDrop same-day delivery could improve health outcomes for patients who use maintenance medications to control chronic conditions.
